<p>All band students are required to have their own materials and bring them to class.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Standard of Excellence Book 1 (please get through Arts Music Shop) • Black 1" 3 ring binder with sheet protectors (20) • Pencil • Hand sanitizer • Tissue • Clorox Wipes • Metronome/tuner (optional) <p>NOTE: Students will also need music books, mouthpieces, drumsticks, and other materials once students are placed on a particular instrument by the second week of school. A more detailed list is on our Website:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A Nylon string classical guitar. If you do not have one, a guitar will be provided to you for the school year. Since the program has grown tremendously since I have been here, I recommend purchasing your own instrument. Please let me know if you would like to purchase a guitar happy to help or make suggestions. • Grades 2 -3: The FJH Young Beginner Guitar Method Book 1, both Lesson Book and Theory Activity Book. Students will be expected to get Book 2 upon completion of Book1 • Grades 4-5: Everybody's Classical Guitar Method 1 (Sutherland, Hoge, Groeber Goni) *available at Art's Music Shop or online at www.amazon.com • Footstool and Clip-on Guitar Tuner (Not required, but very useful) • Pencils • Black 1 or 1 ½ inch Binder for ensemble music and other music given to them by the teacher. I recommend a binder (one inch) and page protectors in order to keep the music from damage. • Dress for the concert is a white shirt, black pants and Girls can wear a black dress. Black dress shoes are preferable, but all black sneakers are also acceptable. The student is also allowed to wear a tie or bowtie if they would like.
